We are thrilled that our Chair of Trustees, Len Preece, has won the Neath Port Talbot Mayor's Volunteer of the Year Award. We are so proud!



Len works tirelessly every day at Canolfan Maerdy – he set up the free fresh food hub and is the main transport of the food, going out every evening between 8 and 10pm to collect and bring back surplus, unsold food from supermarkets in Ammanford and Pontardulais for the local community to collect. He is also the 'Registered Person' for our Lots of Tots Nursery, passionately caring about the welfare and rights of children. Additionally, he carries out numerous tasks at the centre, such as ensuring we get good financial deals for our electric and telephone, helping to maintain equipment at the centre, feeding into Consultation documents and chairing our Board meetings and providing strategic direction as part of his role as a Trustee.

The Award is extremely well deserved; despite being a retired gentleman of many years, Len works full time on a voluntary basis at the Centre. However, alongside this he is also a local community councillor and Chairs the Rural Development Plan Committee.

The charge is just £1.00 per family and gives local parents/grandparents/carers and the children a lovely opportunity to socialise during a morning, have a cuppa/snack, lots of fun and share problems and stories.



## 30 Hour Childcare Scheme



So many working parents are unaware that they can receive **FREE CHILDCARE** in our Lots of Tots Nursery if their child is aged 3-4 years. The Welsh

Government is committed to providing 30 hours per

week of combined early education and childcare for working parents for up to 48 weeks of the year and parents can choose the nursery they would like their child to attend. To be eligible, parents must be working a minimum of 16 hours per week at the national minimum wage or more (in a two parent family, both parents need to be working and a lone parent must be working). For more information, speak to the Nursery Manager or Deputy Managers who will also help you to register your child.

## Community Food Hub

We are very grateful to our 'dynamic duo' Terry Pugh and Geraint Davies for helping to create a wonderful space for our food hub. With new stands kindly donated by an anonymous member of the community, the food is now beautifully displayed and is easier to see. Every day between 9.30am and 4.30pm, local people can call and collect **FREE** delicious fresh and chilled food and flowers kindly donated by local supermarkets - Tesco Stores through its Fareshare scheme, Lidl through its Neighbourly scheme and the Co-op through its Foodshare scheme.



During the past year, our volunteers have collected and delivered to us more than **15 tonnes of free food**, which has been distributed to the local community, equivalent to **31,000 meals** and as far as the prevention of landfill is concerned, we have accomplished an **environmental saving of 47,000 kg of Co<sup>2</sup>**. This is a remarkable achievement by our dedicated volunteers - a **HUGE THANK YOU** to them (especially to Len Preece who started up the initiative) and the supermarkets for helping us to help those who are experiencing a period of financial hardship.

## Maerdy Youth Group

As well as their evening sessions, the Youth enjoyed day time activities during the school Easter Holidays. This included crafts, cooking, sports, a visit to the cinema and quizzes. Members also took part in Llandeilo's BGP Estate Agents, 'Design Your Own Easter Egg' Competition. The group enjoy a whole range of fun activities including music, dance, cooking and craft sessions, trips and residential stays. A trip to Drayton Manor Park is currently being planned for June and new members are always welcome. The session activity programme for May is currently being finalised and will be published as soon as it is available.
